"Vlakernoba" in Zugdidi

On July 15 each year religious holiday "Vlakernoba" is celebrated in Zugdidi.

This is the only day of the year when the holy relic - Saint Mary's robe is taken out of storage in Dadiani Palace museum and available for the public to pay their respects. The first international festival of Megrelian folklore "Kolkhi and ..." will be held in parallel in the previous and next days of the holiday.



July 29 - "Svanetoba"

On July 29, the exhibition of traditional Svanetian cuisine and folk crafts will be open in Mestia.

Everyone can attend the event.



Festival "Land of Legends" in Martvili

On 22 and 25 July, the International Folklore Festival "Land of Legends" will be held at Martvili Culture House.


Together with local groups, folk nsembles groups from Thailand, Slovakia, Bulgaria, Belarus, Ukraine and Sierra Leone will participate.

"Kvirikoba" in Svaneti

On 28 July, religious holiday "Kvirikoba" is celebrated in the village of Kala, which is attended by a large number of pilgrims from different regions of Georgia as well as international visitors.

On this holiday, which is also called "Lagurka", traditionally the locals used to donate white bull to the church.



At the Seti Square, guests will have the opportunity to taste local cuisine and see the artworks of folk art.

Attendance is free.
